Lázaro wants the letter to come to the attention of many readers and be praised, but it is addressed to one individual; 3. he is a mere town crier occupying a very lowly job but rejects money as a reward, craving fame instead! 4. his letter opens promising great things ("cosas tan señaladas") but later he calls it a trifle written in a crude style (nonada que en este grosero estilo escribo"); 5. He affects modesty (no más santo que mis vecinos") but is proud of his achievement; 6. He is asked to write only about the "matter" but takes it upon himself to give a full account
