Does God have this kind of knowledge logically or explanatorily prior to his decree to create a world? This is a subject of considerable theological controversy. Proponents of middle knowledge follow the Catholic Counter-Reformer Luis Molina in the late 16 th, early 17 th century in maintaining that God does have this kind of knowledge. But a good many contemporary theologians would say no - God doesn't have this kind of knowledge.
